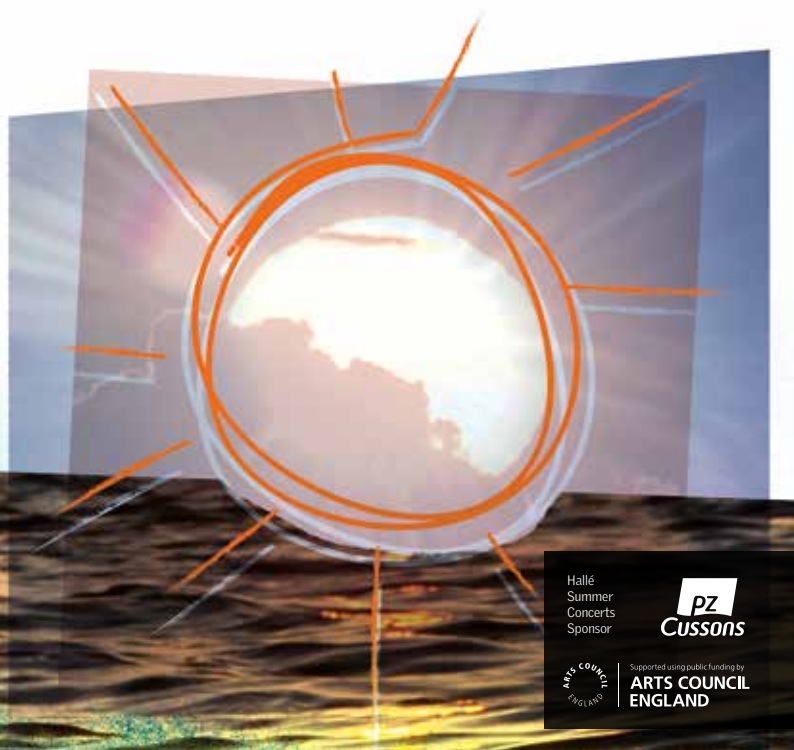

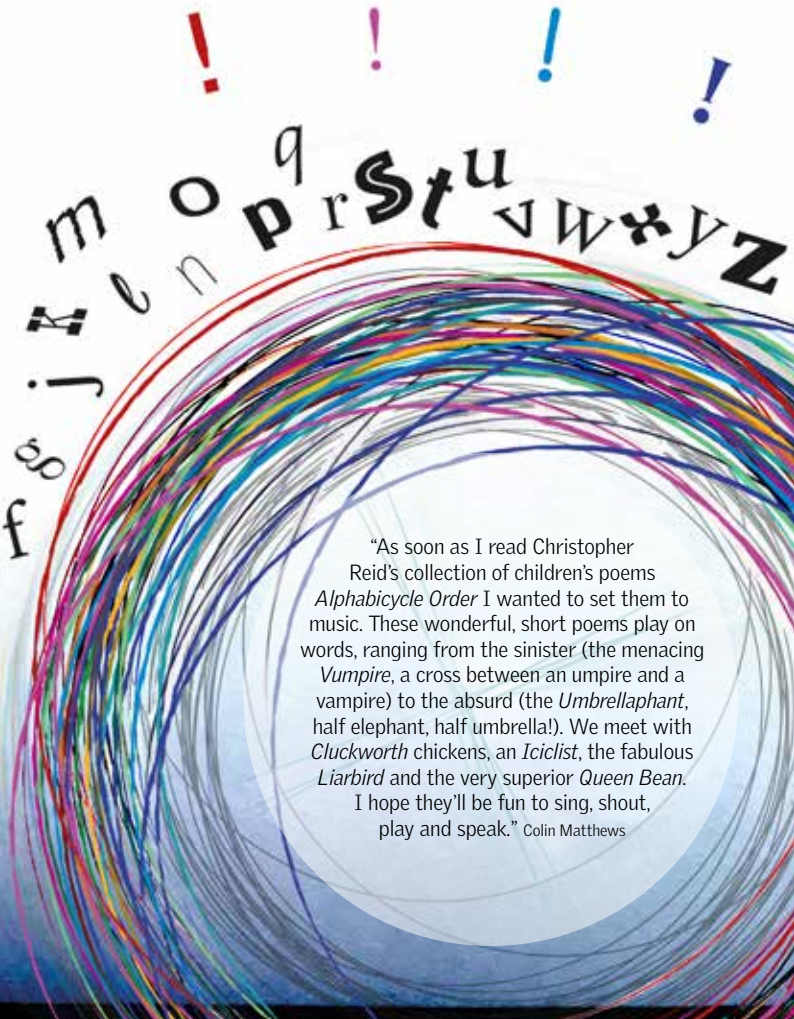

Coaches can drop off and pick up outside the main entrance on Lower Mosley Street.

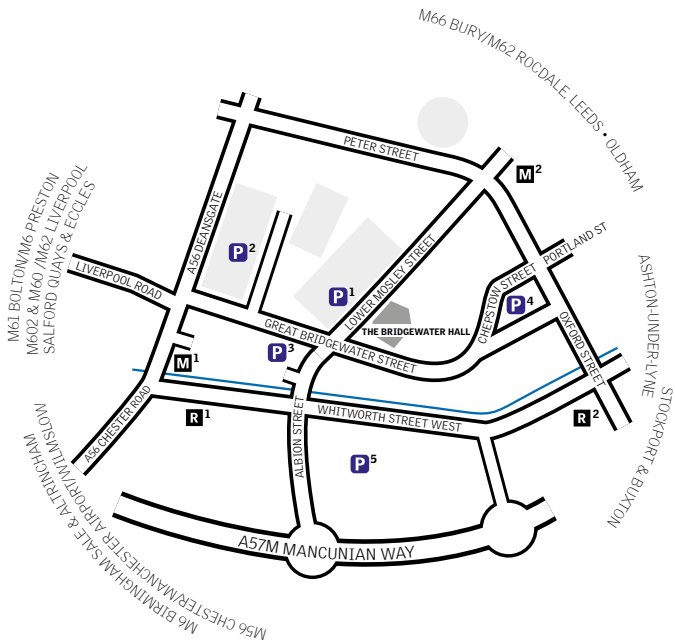
